- Founded on October 4, 1875 by the Decree of Austro-Hungarian emperor Franz Joseph I.
- In 2000 the institution gained the status of National University.

Our main scientific directions are:


 Study of human impacts on ecosystems using microcosm models

- In connection with this our chair needs upgrading of material and technical resources for carrying out researches


- Each year 25 bachelors and 20 masters graduate from the Department.






The regional concept of Environmental education was created, published and is implementing.
